

The Great Blue Heron is one of many kinds of birds that can be seen feeding along the St. Johns River. These majestic birds can stand up to 4 feet tall and have a wingspan of 6 feet. Their blue-gray color, S-shaped neck, and black stripe above their yellow eyes are among a few



of its unique characteristics. It is common to see this bird wading through shallow waters to stalk its prey, and strike like lightning to grab its next meal.
